

## **Streetscape Observation Cheat-Sheet**

**Simile:** a word or phrase used to compare two unlike objects, ideas, thoughts or feelings to provide a clearer description using the words like or as (ex. as big as an elephant)

**Metaphor:** a word or phrase used to compare two unlike objects, ideas, thoughts or feelings to provide a clearer description (ex. the classroom was a zoo)

**Rhyme:** words or phrases with the same ending sound (ex. dog and log)

**Personification:** giving human characteristics to a non-living thing or idea (ex. the sun is smiling)

**Alliteration:** two or more words in a row or near each other, starting with the same sound (ex. winds whipping wildly)

**Repetition:** doing or saying something over and over and over again.
